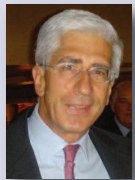
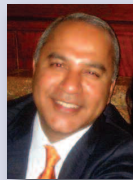

It will also provide state of the art knowledge in all aspects of therapeutic semi-rigid and flexible uretero-rensoscopy as well as the management of complications.
