Rationale of the course

he treatments for Prostate cancer and Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia are quickly evolving. Nowadays, robot-assisted laparoscopic radical prostatectomy is the gold standard of the surgical treatments for prostate cancer.

The improvements in the understanding of prostatic surgical anatomy bring towards better functional results. Several robotic approaches were born in the last years: the standard anterior, the Retzius-sparing, the perineal one.

Tips and tricks, advantages and disadvantages of each approach will be shown and discussed in live and semi-live surgery by worldwide known top surgeons. Also in the case of benign hyperplasia, surgery has been completely renewed by the evolution of technology: lasers, new energies and different approaches to adenoma treatment (including prostatic arteries embolization) have reduced complications improving outcomes.

Finally, new medical treatments concerning both benign hyperplasia and advanced prostate cancer are changing and the dogmas that have been established in the last 30 years are evolving. Expert panels will make the point of the current knowledge on these topics.






